#### 2014 Boston Artadia Award Finalists

Artadia is pleased to announce the third Boston Artadia Award cycle. The image-based application was open to all Boston based visual artists, and closed on October 24th, 2014. First round jurors Christopher Bedford, Director of The Rose Art Museum at Brandeis University; Ruba Katrib, Curator at Sculpture Center and New York-based painter Ryan Sullivan, convened in late October to review all of the applications and selected 10 Finalists. Christopher Bedford will be joined by second-round jurors Bartholomew Ryan, Assistant Curator at The Walker Art Center and Gretchen Wagner, Artistic Director and Chief Curator at the Oklahoma Contemporary, to conduct studio visits with the finalists in November. The 2014 Boston Artadia Awardees will be announced in late November. Artadia will partner with the Arts & Business Council of Greater Boston so that Awardees will receive additional support through the Arts & Business Council's professional development programming.


