21c Museum Hotels, a multi-venue contemporary art museum and award-winning hospitality company, and **Artadia**, a nonprofit grantmaker and nationwide community of visual artists, curators, and patrons, are thrilled to announce that **Kathy Liao** has been selected as the 2022 21c Kansas City Artadia Awardee.

The 2022 21c Kansas City Artadia Award is generously supported by 21c Museum Hotels, the Artadia Board of Directors, Artadia Council Members, and individual donors across the country.

The Awardee will receive \$10,000 in unrestricted funds. In addition to the financial Award of \$10,000, all Awardees have access to the ongoing benefits of the Artadia Awards program. The 2022 21c Kansas City Artadia Award application was open to visual artists working in any visual media, at any stage in their career, living and working within **Cass, Clay, Jackson, Johnson, Leavenworth, Miami, Platte, Ray, and Wyandotte Counties.**

The decision was reached after an extensive two-tiered jurying process, culminating in virtual studio visits with jurors **Daisy Nam**, Executive Director and Curator, Ballroom Marfa, and **Ikechukwu Onyewuenyi**, Curatorial Assistant, Hammer Museum.

Juror **Onyewuenyi** shared sentiments about the award process, “It’s been a really fortunate experience to get both a bird’s eye view of the Kansas City art community alongside a series of intimate, generative conversations about a few artists’ practice. This variable level of engagement provided a sense of the artistic networks that exist across this Midwest City as well as what sustains the nodes within them.”

Fellow juror **Nam** remarked on Liao’s work: “I was taken by Liao’s large-scale paintings that unabashedly take up space, not as a means to occupy, but as a way to fully invite viewers into the work. While her works stem from a personal place of familial stories, memories, and experiences, these intimacies can be felt by her viewers. Her use of scale, textures, layers of paint and striking colors, enliven our senses and awaken the stories that lie within each of us.”

“The sustaining factor dovetailed across the histories of the land, as well as the intimate bonds that care for time, from the here and now to moments that have passed. Taking history, time, and intimacy into consideration, I both felt and saw a shimmering to Liao’s paintings that feel quiet, that keep you submerged in the effect at each layer,” stated **Onyewuenyi**. “It looks and feels like an iridescent collage of time. These shards of intimacy, surfacing on the surface of Liao’s canvas, capture something about the technological moment where our actual and virtual worlds collide like crystal images, ones riddled with déjà-vu. I’m excited with how this Artadia grant pushes these crystal images into Liao’s sculpture practice.”

“On behalf of 21c, congratulations to Kathy Liao on the 2022 Artadia/21c award. Kathy’s multi-media practice illuminates a wide range of insights into contemporary conditions, from the immigrant experience to our relationship with technology to how memory shapes perception and perspective,” says 21c Chief Curator **Alice Gray Stites**. “We are proud that her work has been exhibited at 21c Kansas City, and look forward to witnessing how her practice will grow after receiving this award. We are also grateful to the jurors for their thoughtful time and efforts spent with the three talented finalists for the second Artadia/21c award, and look forward to continuing this collaboration in support of individual artists in vibrant communities like Kansas City.”
